PURPOSE OF THE POST

To provide maintenance and facilities support to ensure the safe running of the Rising Sun as a public arts venue open for events and arts activities.

To provide practical building maintenance – sympathetic and sensitive to the building’s status as a Grade II historic former temperance house in the heart of Reading.

To work with the Venue Co-ordinator and with a team of volunteers to ensure the centre is safe, clean and tidy, with established processes and procedures for the smooth running of public and private events.

MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

To provide maintenance and practical building support to the Venue Co-ordinator and the Maintenance Team. The duties will fall into the following areas:

1. Building Maintenance

- Addressing issues within the structural, electrical, or plumbing domains of the facility
- Carrying out basic repairs where competent and qualified, and booking and contracting experts for specialised repairs
- Overseeing and organising preventative maintenance to avoid costly repairs
- Responding to emergencies such as leaks and power outages
- Overseeing the drains and ensuring they are unblocked and working (or booking appropriate drainage professionals)
- Overseeing chimneys ensuring they are swept annually
- Day-to-day tasks such as changing lightbulbs, managing equipment and basic DIY repairs
- Carrying out and co-ordinating repairs/maintenance for residential flat on site
- Managing cleaning products and managing a paid cleaner (TBC)
- Managing cleaner to perform janitorial duties to keep spaces hygienic and presentable
- Recycling and bins

2. Equipment and furniture

- Overseeing maintenance and upkeep of bar infrastructure such as a fridges, air con units, bar optics



- Overseeing venue furniture and making sure extraneous furniture or broken furniture is disposed of

3. Storage, portage, signage

- Maintaining storage areas ensuring they are tidy, well-run, managed, accessible to all staff and volunteers
- Maintaining and moving tables, chairs, equipment for events
- Maintaining clear and presentable signage for public facing events and for volunteers back of house
- Managing the overhaul of the carpark area storage facilities (sheds in carpark)
- Managing the overhaul of the centre's interior storage facilities (cupboards)

4. Building Security and Safety

- Ensuring the carpark is secure with lockable gate
- Managing keys to the building and who has access
- First aid boxes – maintaining up to date first aid boxes and equipment
- Servicing extinguishers fire alarm

Experience Required

- Experience of carrying out caretaker and maintenance duties in a similar environment e.g. school, building, listed building, community centre, office, restaurant, pub
- Experience of maintaining old buildings – desirable, but not essential
- Experience of booking and contracting third party specialists
